If one or more tyres are not made by authorised brands LeasePlan will debit, along with the reconditioning, a sum for each tyre, which will be equivalent to the average values at authorised brands. In addition, LeasePlan does not accept any winter tyres, regardless of the brand.

For vehicles equipped with an anti-puncture kit, if the sealant has been used, let us remind you that this must be replaced before the vehicle is returned. If you have contracted a tyre service from LeasePlan and the sealant was used following a puncture on the vehicle in question, the replacement of this falls under the scope of the contract, so it should be refilled at a brand representative garage on the LeasePlan network.
